The Tulsa FOP 93 Health and Welfare Trust is committed to the health of our members. Studies have shown that smokers have as much as a 40% higher health care costs over non-smokers. Smokeless tobacco, cigars, pipe tobacco, and E-Cigarettes are directly linked to oral cancer, dental and gum diseases, heart disease, high blood pressure and stroke. As a part of the 2017-2018 wellness plan the Trust is offering premium incentives for those that test negative for nicotine on their PHA or before 10/31/17.
