When should you use this claim form?

Use this claim form to submit a Voluntary Benefits Accident claim to Unum.

Who is responsible for completing this claim form?

The information provided on this claim form will be used to evaluate your eligibility for Accident benefits. Please provide complete and legible responses to ensure your claim is processed as quickly as possible. Please enclose any additional information you feel will assist us in the evaluation of your claim.

- **Insured/Patient/Policyholder Statement (pages 4-5):** Please complete this section of the claim form and fax the completed form to 1-800-447-2498. If you prefer, it may be mailed to the address noted above.
- Please complete the name and date of birth fields at the top of every page for easy identification in case the pages become separated. The policy owner is considered the insured, the patient may also be the policy owner or may be the spouse, domestic partner or dependent child of the policy owner.
- **Authorization to Share Information with Third Parties (page 6):** If you wish to give us permission to share the details of your claim with a third party (such as your spouse, son, daughter, friend, etc.), please sign and date this form and fax it to 1-800-447-2498. Fraud Warning
